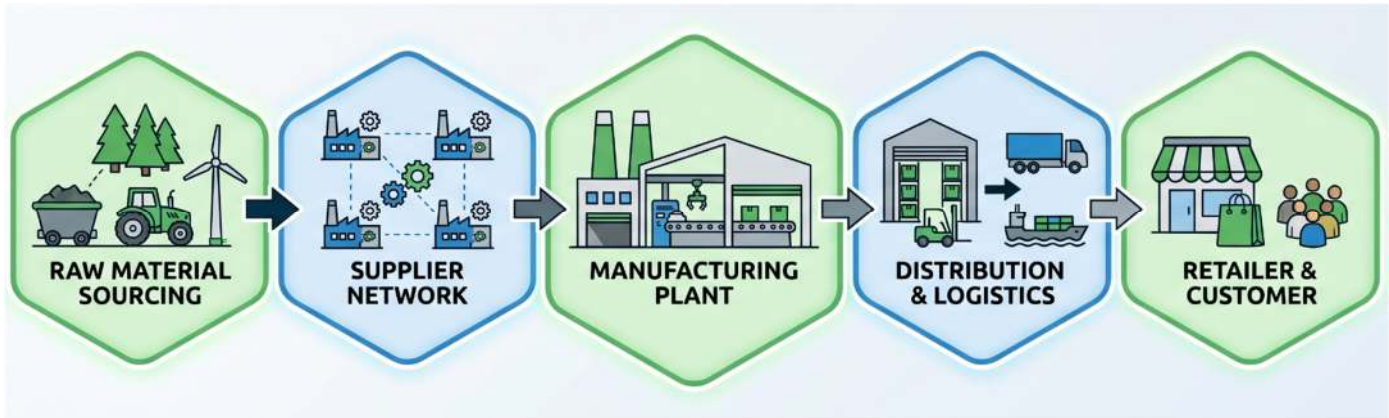


Banning of Importation of Products of Forced Labor

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Ministry of Economy and Finance, Ministry of Commerce and Ministry of Labor and Vocational Training, on 01 July 2026, have issued a joint Prakas No. 450 on the Banning of Importation of Products of Forced Labor (“**Inter-Ministerial Prakas**”).

Based on the Inter-Ministerial Prakas, any products that involve forced labor must be banned from importation, uses, or distribution in the Kingdom of Cambodia. The importer that is suspected of possessing products that involve forced labor, must provide clarification to inter-ministerial working group within 10 (ten) working day, starting from the date of receiving notification on the inspection of products suspected of involving forced labor. The clarification must attach the information and document as follows:

- proof of products origin and production location;
- name and information for manufacturer or concerned individual in supply chain;
- operation of manufacturing, extracting, harvesting, modifying, assembly or other related activities;
- sale-purchase agreement, payment document, ownership transfer document or other related documents;
- compliance audit report, evaluation report or other documents that can clarify the noninvolvement of forced labor

In the event it is identified that the imported products involve forced labor, such product will be banned from importation, uses, or distribution in Cambodia. Additionally, the importer of products that involve forced labor will be punished as follows:

- suspension of import-export activities;
- suspension of issuance of certificate of origin;
- other legal actions in accordance with the law.
